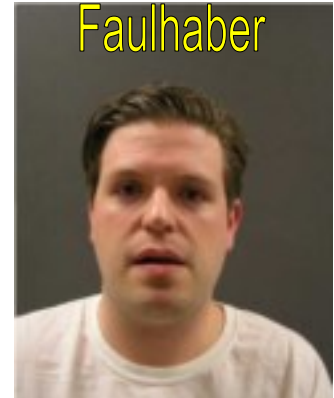

DWI Arrest

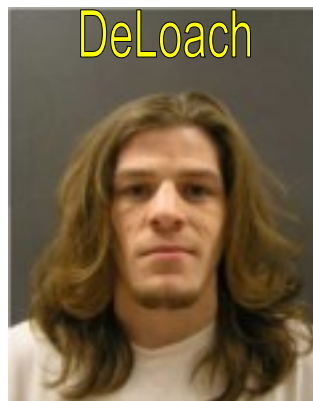
On Friday, February 5th, **Officer Jeff Burbank** stopped a vehicle without headlights on and weaving. He met with the driver who appeared to be intoxicated. **Officer Mike Thul** arrived to assist. Field sobriety tests were administered, and Faulhaber failed a preliminary breath test. Ofc. Burbank determined the driver, Daniel Faulhaber, 33, was under the influence. When Ofc. Burbank attempted to arrest Faulhaber, he stated “no, no,

no” and began resisting the officers. He struggled and pulled his arms away when they tried to handcuff Faulhaber. The officers eventually handcuffed him without injury, and he was transported to the jail. Faulhaber refused to provide a breath sample. He was charged with 3rd degree DWI, 2nd degree DWI - test refusal, and Obstruction of Legal Process. He was released on his own recognizance.



Should Have Gone with the Skinny Jeans

On Friday, February 5th, **Officer DJ Skluzacek** stopped a vehicle for an equipment violation. As he was speaking with the vehicle’s two occupants, he could smell the odor of marijuana coming from inside the vehicle. The passenger, Matthew DeLoach, 22, admitted to Ofc. Skluzacek that he had smoked marijuana earlier in the night. **Officers Adam Marvin** and **Mike Thul** arrived to assist. As the two occupants were removed from the vehicle, Ofc. Marvin saw a pipe fall from DeLoach’s pant leg. In searching him further, Ofc.



Thul found a small baggie with suspected methamphetamine residue inside, and DeLoach

admitted the bag had indeed contained methamphetamine. As DeLoach was being handcuffed, a baggie containing marijuana and a methamphetamine pipe fell from his sweatpants. DeLoach was arrested and transported to jail. During booking, a container of marijuana wax was discovered inside of his pockets. He was charged with 5th degree Controlled Substances (two counts) and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia. His bail was set at \$1,000 with conditions.

Assault Arrest

On Wednesday, February 10th, **Officers Chris Tonjum, Greta Luiken, Matt Shuda** and **Sergeant Mark Krenik** responded to a reported assault. The caller reported that one person’s nose was broken and the suspect had fled. A person at the residence told officers that the suspect, Demarcus Barker, 36, had come to the residence and gotten into a dispute with her husband. She thought the argument had calmed down when Barker punched her in the side of the head, causing her to fall to the

ground. The officers found a second victim holding a towel to his face with an obviously deformed nose. Nightshift officers took up the search for Barker after receiving information where he was hiding. **Officers Said Hilowle, Malory House, Jeff Burbank, Keith Voegel, John Pesta** and **Sergeant Eric Sammon** surveilled the residence and met with the resident, who sent Barker out of the house. He was arrested without incident. He was charged with 3rd degree Assault and 5th degree

assault. His bail was set at \$10,000 with conditions.
