Pole Crashing

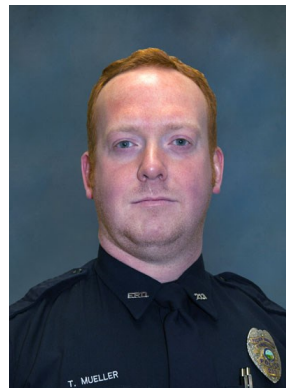

Jurgensen was arrested and jailed. He was charged with Driving After Revocation and 5th degree Controlled Substances. His bail was set at \$1,000 with conditions.

thoughts and prayers are with you.

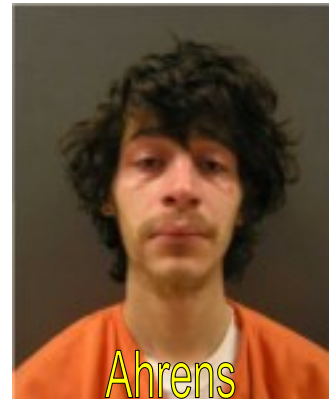
Our wishes also go to **Records Clerk Carole Friesz** and her family, who lost her grandmother this week.

Two Noses Are Better Than One

On Friday, March 25th, **Officer Josh Sjodin** stopped a vehicle for a license violation. In meeting with the driver, Cody Ahrens, 23, Ofc. Sjodin determined that his driving privileges were "revoked". Ofc. Sjodin could smell the odor of marijuana coming from inside Ahrens' vehicle. Ofc. Sjodin found a small bag of suspected marijuana and a pipe where Ahrens had been sitting. **Officer Mike Thul** and **K9 Chase** searched

the vehicle, and located a small baggie containing suspected methamphetamine, a methamphetamine pipe and a small bottle with more marijuana. A passenger in the vehicle told the officers the methamphetamine belonged to Ahrens. He was arrested and jailed. Ahrens was charged with Driving After Revocation and 5th degree Controlled Substances. He was released on his own recognizance.

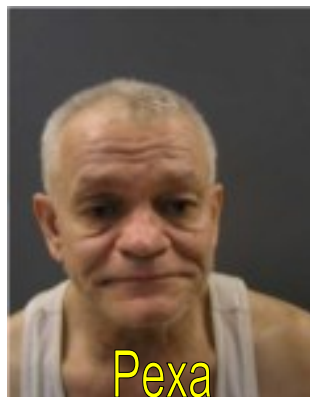
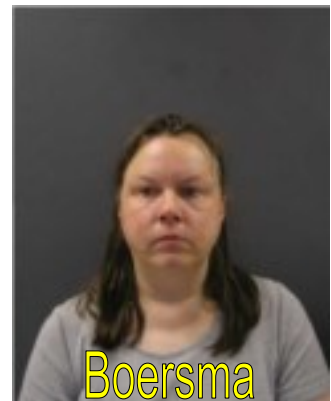

Search Warrant Arrests

On Monday, March 28th, agents of the **Cannon River Drug and Violent Offender Task Force** executed a search warrant at a Faribault residence. The investigation was the result of information about drug use and sales at the residence. The agents were assisted by **Detective Matt Kolling**, **Officer Matt Shuda**, **Sergeants Brandon Glien** and **Eric Sammon**, **RCSO Deputy Steve Bauer**, **Sergeant Nate Budin**, **Investigators Paul LaRoche** and **Nate Hanson**. Inside the residence, agents found numerous items of drug paraphernalia, over three grams of methamphetamine, two baggies containing marijuana and items associated with narcotics sales. Three residents, **Wayne Pexa**, 59, **Julie Boersma**, 45, and **Scott Pew**, 51, were arrested and jailed. Pexa was charged with 5th degree Controlled Substances, and he was released on his own recognizance. Boersma was charged with 5th degree Controlled Substances, and was released on her own recognizance. Pew was also charged with 5th degree Controlled Substances, and released on his own recognizance. A fourth

resident, **Thomas Brown**, 52, was released from the scene but charged by complaint summons with 5th degree Controlled Substances.
