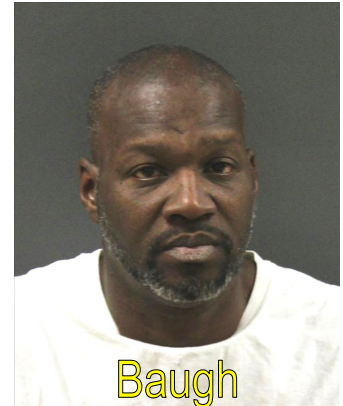

Burglar Busted

On Saturday, August 20th, two out-of-state investigators were conducting surveillance on a burglary suspect and followed him to Faribault. They witnessed the man enter a closed business and leave within a few minutes. The investigators contacted **Sergeant Mark Krenik** to report the burglary. **Officers John Pesta, Keith Voegel, Said Hilowle, and Greta Luiken** responded to investigate the burglary. The

suspect, Johnnie Baugh, 52, of Mason City, IA, was stopped by State Troopers in Owatonna and returned to Faribault. **Sergeant Brandon Gliem** also responded to assist with the investigation. Baugh was jailed and charged with 3rd degree Burglary. His bail was set at \$10,000 with conditions.

Freeway Fatality

On Saturday, August 13th, Officers were dispatched to a crash on I-35. **Officers Justin Hunt, Matt Shuda, John Pesta, Chris Tonjum and Sergeant Eric Sammon** arrived to find several vehicles involved, including one on fire with a trapped occupant. **RCSO Deputy Lisa Arens, Sergeant Ross Spicer, Sheriff Troy Dunn and State Troopers Travis Boetel and Bill Tjon** also arrived to assist. The

officers worked to keep the flames away from the trapped person. A citizen passer-by with a pressure washer stopped to assist and spray water. **FFD Firefighters Josh Bauer, Rick Martinez, Ryan Maas, Brandon Ableman, Jason Bauer, Ryan Bauer, Andy Boevers, Pat DeGroot, Matt DeGroot, John Milewski, Cody Roushar, Jon Sheridan, Chris Bauer, Jonah Bauer, Alex Bolster, Jon**

Vargo, John Wunderlich and Chief Dusty Dienst all responded for the rescue. All personnel worked very diligently to extricate, treat and transport five motorists involved in the crash. Domestic Assault Arrest

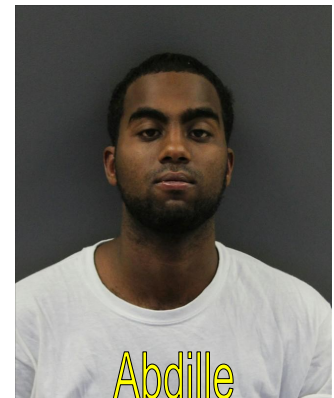
Officer Karl Willers met with a woman on Tuesday, August 23rd, who reported a domestic assault. She stated her boyfriend had become upset with her and placed her in a choke hold, making it difficult to breathe. She reported he also held a knife to her back and threatened to kill her if she called for help. The woman’s roommate interrupted the assault and the suspect left the residence. **Officer Josh Sjodin**



located and arrested the suspect, Noah Goodwin, 18, the following day. Goodwin, who was previously arrested in July in connection to another domestic assault, was charged with 2nd degree Assault, Terroristic Threats, Domestic Assault by Strangulation and Domestic Assault. His bail was set at \$35,000 with conditions.

Robbers Tracked Down

On Tuesday, August 16th, **Officers DJ Skluzacek** and **Lisa Petricka** responded to a report of a robbery. The victim reported he had been at a city park with some other males. He stated one of the suspects pinned his arms, while a second suspect punched him in the face, took his phone and money, and both fled. He was only able to provide descriptions and nicknames of the suspects. **Officers Adam Marvin, Karl Willers** and **Detective Scott Duncan** assisted with the investigation. Ofc. Skluzacek was able to identify both suspects. Brandon Hammond, 25, was found at his girlfriend’s resi-



dence and arrested. Mohamed Abdille, 24, was found at his residence and also arrested. Hammond was charged with Simple Robbery and Theft, and

his bail was set at \$20,000 with conditions. Abdille was charged with Aid and Abet Simple Robbery, and his bail was set at \$10,000 with conditions.

Early Morning DWI

Just before 7am on Sunday, August 21st, **Officer Justin Hunt** responded to a report of a car loudly revving its engine. As he arrived in the area, he could hear a car engine revving to “extreme RPMs”. He saw the car back out of a driveway, rev its engine again and discharge thick black smoke, and park in the driveway. He met with the driver, Kin Kue, 27, who presented an instruction permit. **Officer Chris Tonjum** arrived to assist. Kue

displayed physical signs of intoxication and admitted to drinking. Ofc. Tonjum could see several empty beer cans in the yard near the vehicle. Ofc. Hunt administered field sobriety tests to Kue, and placed him under arrest. At the jail, Kue submitted to a breath test, which resulted in a .19 BAC. Kue was charged with 2nd degree DWI and Violation of Instruction Permit. He was released on his own recognizance.
