Missing Juvenile

We are seeking the public's assistance in locating a missing juvenile. 17 year old **Pedro Jeremias Chel Cobo**, was last seen by family on Sunday September 11, 2016. On Wednesday, family reported to Law Enforcement that Pedro has been missing. Family signed Pedro as a missing person. Pedro is from Guatemala and has only been in Faribault for approximately 5 1/2 months. Pedro does not drive, he does not have access to a motor vehicle, and he does not have a cell phone. Pedro has not been to

school since running away. Family does not believe Pedro to be in any danger.

Pedro is 5'3", 120 pounds, brown hair and brown eyes. He was last seen wearing a white polo shirt, blue jeans, grey tennis shoes and carrying a backpack with soccer gear.

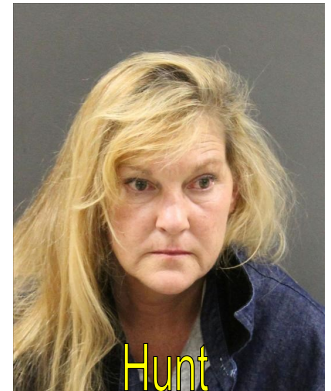

Drug Arrest

On Tuesday, September 13th, **Officer Jeff Burbank** observed a vehicle driving erratically. When he attempted to stop the vehicle, he saw the four occupants continuously moving around as if they were hiding something. **Officers Keith Voegel** and **Greta Luiken** arrived to assist. The driver, **Dustin Holicky**, 33, was found to have a revoked driver’s license. He was cited and released. One of the passen-

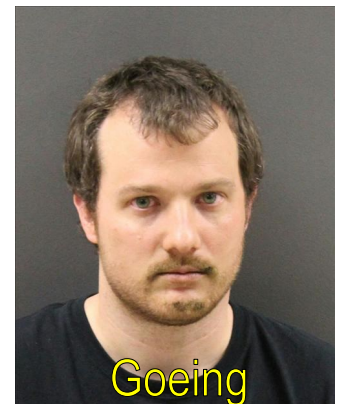

DWI Arrest

On Wednesday, September 14th, **Officers Greta Luiken** and **Jeff Burbank** responded to a vehicle crash. The caller stated a vehicle had crashed into two parked vehicles, and the driver was attempting to leave. On arrival, Ofc. Burbank detected signs of alcohol impairment on the driver, **Michael Goeing**, 32. After refusing to complete standardized field sobriety tests, he was arrested. At the jail, he did not cooper-

ate in providing a breath sample. He was charged with 2nd degree DWI and DWI Test Refusal. His bail was set at \$2,000 with conditions.



On Thursday, September 15th, many of our officers participated in a multi-agency active shooter drill along with the Faribault Fire Department, Rice County Sheriff’s Office, Rice-Steele 911 Center and North Ambulance. The drill was coor-
