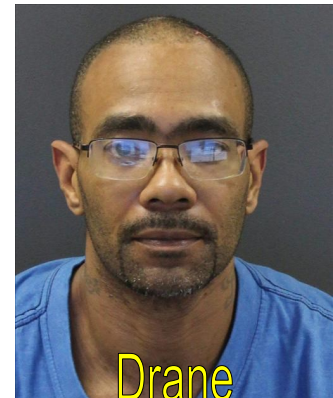

Domestic Assault Arrest

On Friday, February 16th, **Officers Cadie Spicer, Keith Voegel, Allen Anderson, Sean Smallen** and **Sergeant Eric Sammon** responded to a reported domestic assault. One of the victims told Ofc. Voegel that she heard her seven-year-old brother, say that he had been hit. She also told the officers that her father had been acting “crazy”, threatening to harm others and she was scared of his behavior. The victim showed the officers a

video from her phone of the suspect displaying the behaviors she had described. The suspect, **Marquel Drane**, 41, denied assaulting anyone or threatening anyone. He was arrested and jailed. Drane was charged with Domestic Assault (felony) and Terroristic Threats. He was released on his own recognizance by the court.

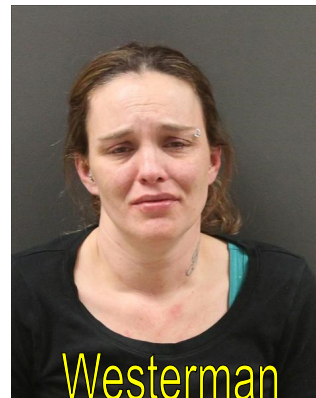

DWI Crash

She asked the driver to complete field sobriety tests, and continued to display signs of intoxication. The driver, **Kristin**



Westerman, 35, was arrested. At the jail, she consented to a breath test which indicated a blood-alcohol concentration of .17. Westerman was cited for 2nd degree DWI, Operating a Vehicle with BAC over .08, and Careless Driving. She was released on her own recognizance by the court.
