## Domestic Assault Arrest

On Thursday, May 3rd, **Officer Michael Shuda** responded to a reported domestic assault. He met with the victim, who stated she had been in her shower when the suspect, the father of her child, entered her residence uninvited, unannounced and without her consent. She stated the suspect began yelling and hitting her, and pushed her down into the bathtub where she struck her head. The suspect also threw her phone into a different room to prevent her

from calling police. Ofc. Shuda could see injuries on the victim consistent with her report. Ofc. Shuda then found the suspect, Contrell Johnson, 29, at his residence. Johnson denied assaulting the victim, and stated he had been assaulted by the victim. Johnson was arrested and jailed. He was charged with 1st degree Burglary (two counts), Domestic Assault and Interference with a Call for Help. His bail was set at \$10,000 with conditions.

## Predatory Offender Notification

According to Minnesota Statute 244.052, the Faribault Police Department is releasing information regarding Darren Everett Sweazey, a Level 3 registrant subject to public notification. Sweazey will move to Faribault on Wednesday, May 16th, and will reside in the 300 block of Willow Street. Sweazey has served the sentence imposed on him by the court, and is transitioning into the community. Sweazey, also



known as Hayden Richter, was previously released to Faribault in 2010. His release is not the result of a new offense.

A Community Notification meeting has been scheduled for 6pm on Tuesday, May 15th at the Faribault Police Department. Representatives from the Department of Corrections and the Faribault Police Department will be available to provide useful information on public safety.

## DWI Arrest

On Thursday, May 3rd, **Officer Mike Thul** responded to a report of an unconscious male in a vehicle. On his arrival, he observed the car stopped partially in a driveway as if it had been backing out, and the man in the driver's seat. Upon awakening the man, Ofc. Thul noted his speech was slurred and he could smell the odor of an alcoholic beverage. The man was unable to stand without assistance, and refused to complete

any field sobriety testing. He was arrested. At the jail, the suspect, Corey Jablinske, 31, declined to take a breath test. He was charged with 1st degree DWI and Refusal to Test. He was released on his own recognizance by the court.



## Napping with Narcotics

**Officers Karl Willers** and **Ben Johns** responded to a report of a male passed out in a vehicle at a local store on Wednesday, May 9th. After knocking several times, the male attempted to roll down the window but eventually opened the door. Ofc. Willers could smell the odor of marijuana coming from inside the vehicle. Upon searching the vehicle, officers found a glass methamphetamine pipe and a baggie containing suspected methamphetamine. The substance later tested positive as

methamphetamine. The officers also found a digital scale and several empty baggies with suspected methamphetamine residue. The suspect, Nathan Stewart, 31, was arrested. He was charged with 5th degree Controlled Substances. The same day, Stewart was subsequently charged with 5th degree controlled substances in connection with an earlier **Cannon River Drug and Violent Offender Task Force** investigation, in which he was found in possession of marijuana wax. His bail was set



at \$10,000 with conditions in both cases.

## Trespassing Arrest

On Tuesday, May 8th, **Officers Brittany Carstensen, Michael Shuda** and **Sergeant Matt Knutson** responded to a trespassing complaint. The caller reported seeing the suspect, Joshua Bluhm, 42, inside of a vacant house undergoing renovation. As officers arrived, they saw Bluhm leaving the area on his bicycle and stopped him. Inside the residence, officers saw items indicating Bluhm had



been sleeping in the house. The owner reported to officers that Bluhm had been told previously to stay out the house, and had posted “no trespassing” signs on the house. Bluhm was arrested and cited for trespassing (two counts).
