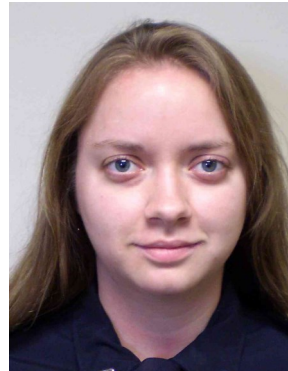

Drug Arrest

On Tuesday, August 8th, **Officer Josh Sjodin** was on patrol and performed a license plate check on a vehicle in traffic. He learned that the registered owner’s driving status was “suspended”. He noted that the driver also matched the description of the registered owner. Ofc. Sjodin stopped the vehicle, and a passenger attempted to walk away. The driver was identified as Richard Grant, 44, and told Ofc. Sjodin that he did have knives in his vehicle. **Officer Michael Shuda** arrived to

assist. As Ofc. Sjodin pat-searched Grant for weapons, he felt what he believed to be a methamphetamine pipe in Grant’s pocket. Grant admitted to Ofc. Sjodin that the item was a pipe. Ofc. Sjodin also discovered a small baggie containing suspected methamphetamine residue. Grant was arrested and jailed. He was charged with Driving After Suspension and 5th degree Controlled Substances. His bail was set at \$5,000.
